AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled
2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the
3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the
4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative
5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,
6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or
7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or
8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative
9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and
10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative
11 officers, and of the several administrative departments,
12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the
13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive
14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of
15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and
16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,
17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the
18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other
19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and
20 commissions shall be determined," further providing for
21 deputy secretaries of the Department of Transportation.

22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
23 hereby enacts as follows:

24 Section 1. Section 2001.3(a) of the act of April 9, 1929
25 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929,
26 amended June 22, 1982 (P.L.573, No.166), is amended to read:

1 Section 2001.3. Deputy Secretaries.--(a) The Secretary of
2 Transportation shall appoint, with the approval of the Governor,
3 six deputy secretaries who shall have the title of Deputy
4 Secretary for Administration, Deputy Secretary for Highway
5 Administration, Deputy Secretary for [Safety Administration]
6 Driver and Vehicle Services, Deputy Secretary for Planning,
7 Deputy Secretary for Local and Area Transportation and Deputy
8 Secretary for Aviation, Rail Freight, Ports and Waterways.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
