- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 1501 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
- 9 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 10 § 1501. Composition and general functions.
- 11 The State Armory Board shall consist of the Adjutant General,
- 12 who shall act as chairman, and [five] eight members appointed by
- 13 the Adjutant General. Three of the members of the State Armory
- 14 Board appointed by the Adjutant General shall be members of the

- 1 Pennsylvania National Guard. The State Armory Board shall
- 2 exercise the powers, duties and provisions of this chapter. The
- 3 board shall appoint a secretary who need not be a member of the
- 4 board. It shall provide, equip, maintain, manage and regulate
- 5 armories for the use of the Pennsylvania military forces. It
- 6 may, with the approval of the Governor, accept gifts of land,
- 7 with or without buildings thereon, to be used for military
- 8 purposes. The title to all such land shall be taken in the name
- 9 of the Commonwealth. It may also employ funds appropriated to it
- 10 to purchase, for armory purposes, any suitable buildings or
- 11 sites.
- 12 Section 2. Title 51 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 13 <u>§ 1713. Veterans' Ombudsman.</u>
- 14 The Deputy Adjutant General for Veterans' Affairs shall
- 15 <u>appoint a Veterans' Ombudsman to receive and investigate</u>
- 16 <u>complaints made by individual veterans concerning medical care</u>
- 17 or services provided by a State medical care facility or
- 18 veterans' home. The Veterans' Ombudsman shall also provide
- 19 information and referrals concerning medical care or services
- 20 provided by a Federal medical care facility or veterans' home.
- 21 SECTION 2. SECTION 1905(B) OF TITLE 51 IS AMENDED TO READ: <
- 22 § 1905. PENNSYLVANIA VETERANS' MEMORIAL TRUST FUND.

- 24 (B) PURPOSE. -- THE MONEYS IN THE FUND SHALL BE USED FOR THE
- 25 SELECTION, DESIGN [AND], CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE
- 26 OF AN APPROPRIATE PHYSICAL MONUMENT ON THE GROUNDS OF THE
- 27 INDIANTOWN GAP NATIONAL CEMETERY AND OTHER COSTS INCIDENTAL
- 28 THERETO.

- 30 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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- 1 SECTION 3. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AS FOLLOWS: <---

- 3 IN 60 DAYS.
