AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), entitled "An 2 act relating to insurance; amending, revising, and 3 consolidating the law providing for the incorporation of insurance companies, and the regulation, supervision, and protection of home and foreign insurance companies, Lloyds 5 associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and 7 fire insurance rating bureaus, and the regulation and 8 supervision of insurance carried by such companies, associations, and exchanges, including insurance carried by 9 10 the State Workmen's Insurance Fund; providing penalties; and 11 repealing existing laws, providing for notification of 12 clinical trial insurance coverage.
- 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 14 hereby enacts as follows:
- 15 Section 1. The act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known
- 16 as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, is amended by adding a
- 17 section read:
- 18 <u>Section 631.1. Notification of Clinical Trial Coverage.--(a)</u>
- 19 An insurer shall notify an insured of clinical trial services
- 20 that qualify for coverage under the insured's health insurance

- 2 (b) (1) The term "insurer" when used in this section means
- 3 any entity that issues an individual or group health insurance
- 4 policy.
- 5 (2) The term "health insurance policy" when used in this
- 6 section means any individual or group health insurance policy,
- 7 <u>subscriber contract, certificate or plan which provides medical</u>
- 8 or health care coverage by any health care facility or licensed
- 9 <u>health care provider which is offered by or is governed under</u>
- 10 this act or any of the following:
- 11 (i) Subarticle (f) of Article IV of the act of June 13, 1967
- 12 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the "Public Welfare Code."
- 13 (ii) The act of December 29, 1972 (P.L.1701, No.364), known
- 14 <u>as the "Health Maintenance Organization Act."</u>
- 15 <u>(iii) The act of May 18, 1976 (P.L.123, No.54), known as the</u>
- 16 <u>"Individual Accident and Sickness Insurance Minimum Standards</u>
- 17 <u>Act."</u>
- 18 (iv) The act of December 14, 1992 (P.L.835, No.134), known
- 19 <u>as the "Fraternal Benefit Societies Code."</u>
- 20 (v) A nonprofit corporation subject to 40 Pa.C.S. Chs. 61
- 21 (relating to hospital plan corporations) and 63 (relating to
- 22 professional health services plan corporations).
- 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
