Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for criminal 3 trespass. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 3503 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 3503. Criminal trespass. 9 10 (b.3) School trespasser.--11 (1) A person commits an offense if he: (i) fails to obey notices posted in a manner 12 13 prescribed by law or reasonably likely to come to the 14 person's attention at each entrance of school grounds 15 that visitors are prohibited without authorization from the school principal or designee; A DESIGNATED SCHOOL, 16
