AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An  
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain  
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial  
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the  
5 laws relating thereto," further providing for possession of  
6 weapons.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 1317.2(g) of the act of March 10, 1949  
10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,  
11 amended June 25, 1997 (P.L.297, No.30), is amended to read:

12 Section 1317.2. Possession of Weapons Prohibited.--\* \* \*  
13 (g) As used in this section, the term "weapon" shall  
14 include, but not be limited to, any knife, including a pocket  
15 knife, regardless of the size of its blade, cutting instrument,  
16 cutting tool, nunchaku, firearm, shotgun, rifle and any other  
17 tool, instrument or implement capable of inflicting serious  
18 bodily injury.

19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
