AN ACT

1 Designating a portion of Pennsylvania ~~Traffic Route 33 Extension~~ <—
2 STATE ROUTE 33 in Northampton County as the General Anthony <—
3 Clement McAuliffe 101st Airborne Memorial Highway.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. General Anthony Clement McAuliffe 101st Airborne
7 Memorial Highway.

8 (a) Designation.--The section of ~~Pennsylvania Traffic~~ STATE <—
9 Route 33 ~~Extension~~ in Northampton County from ~~United States~~ <—
10 ~~Traffic~~ STATE Route 22 to Interstate ~~Highway~~ Route I-78 78 is <—
11 hereby designated the General Anthony Clement McAuliffe 101st
12 Airborne Memorial Highway.

13 (b) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
14 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to

- 1 traffic in both directions on the highway.
- 2 Section 2. Effective date.
