## AN ACT

Providing for a pilot project for accident reports; and
 establishing the Accident Report Form Study Committee.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Short title.

6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Accident

7 Report Form Study Committee Act.

8 Section 2. Definitions.

9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:

12 "Accident report." A report of a vehicular accident that is 13 submitted by a police department on a form prepared by the 14 Department of Transportation pursuant to the provisions of 75 15 Pa.C.S. §§ 3751 (relating to reports by police) and 3752 1 (relating to accident report forms).

2 "Committee." The Accident Report Form Study Committee3 established by this act.

4 "Department." The Department of Transportation of the5 Commonwealth.

6 "Secretary." The Secretary of Transportation of the7 Commonwealth.

8 Section 3. Accident report form pilot project.

9 (a) Authorization.--The department shall conduct a pilot 10 project at ten locations across this Commonwealth for the 11 purpose of collecting accident reports on the form that is used 12 by the department on the effective date of this act. The project 13 shall be administered as follows:

14 (1) Each location shall be selected by the department
15 and shall consist of a municipality with a population equal
16 to 50,000 persons or less.

17 (2) The accident reports shall be completed for a period
18 of 90 days on the form used by the department on the
19 effective date of this act.

20 (b) Limitation.--Notwithstanding any other provision of 75 21 Pa.C.S. (relating to vehicles) to the contrary, the form used by 22 the department on the effective date of this act may not be used 23 in any other location of this Commonwealth until the pilot 24 program is expanded in accordance with section 4(c).

25 Section 4. Accident Report Form Study Committee.

(a) Establishment.--The Accident Report Form Study Committee
is hereby established. The committee shall consist of the
following members:

29 (1) The secretary or his designee.

30 (2) Three members of the department who are appointed by 20020H2331B3225 - 2 -

1 the secretary.

2 (3) A representative of the Pennsylvania Association of
3 Police Chiefs, designated by the head of the association.

4 (4) Four members of the General Assembly, one of whom
5 shall be appointed by the President pro tempore of the
6 Senate, one of whom shall be appointed by the Minority Leader
7 of the Senate, one of whom shall be appointed by the Speaker
8 of the House of Representatives and one of whom shall be
9 appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of
10 Representatives.

11 (b) Duties.--The committees shall review and study the accident reports collected by the department under the pilot 12 13 project established under section 3. The committee shall also 14 solicit and consider the comments of police departments 15 regarding the amount of time and effort to complete the accident 16 reports and any other comments about the accident report forms. 17 The purpose of the review shall be to determine whether the 18 accident report form is the most effective and efficient means 19 to collect data on vehicular accidents while balancing the 20 administrative demands placed on police departments by the completion of the accident reports. 21

22 Expansion of pilot program.--If, after completing its (C) 23 review, the committee determines by majority vote that the accident report form is the most effective and efficient means 24 to collect data on vehicular accidents while balancing the 25 26 administrative demands of police departments, the department 27 shall expand the use of the accident report form to the entire 28 Commonwealth. Otherwise, the committee shall recommend changes to the content of the accident report form, and the department 29 30 shall implement the changes and expand the use of the changed 20020H2331B3225 - 3 -

- 1 accident report form to the entire Commonwealth.
- 2 Section 5. Effective date.
- 3 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
