AN ACT

- 1 Requiring public notice of certain real property purchases by
- the Commonwealth; and providing for a right of certain public
- 3 officials to examine and review Inspector General reports.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the State
- 8 Government Accountability Act.
- 9 Section 2. Notice of real property purchase.
- 10 Whenever an agency of State Government intends to enter into
- 11 a contract to purchase real property valued at more than
- 12 \$100,000, the agency shall first publish a description of the
- 13 project and proposed criteria for the selection of real estate
- 14 in the Pennsylvania Bulletin at least 30 days before any
- 15 contract is signed or a specific property is selected.
- 16 Section 3. Right to examine and review Inspector General

- 1 reports.
- 2 (a) General rule. -- Upon request, the Attorney General,
- 3 Auditor General and State Treasurer shall have the right to
- 4 examine and review all reports prepared by the Inspector General
- 5 on State programs or contracts when the Attorney General
- 6 conducts a criminal investigation on relevant programs or
- 7 contracts or when the Auditor General or State Treasurer
- 8 exercise their official duties under the act of April 9, 1929
- 9 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code.
- 10 (b) Temporary delay of release of report.--The Inspector
- 11 General may temporarily delay the releasing of a report up to 30
- 12 days from the date of the request of the Attorney General,
- 13 Auditor General or State Treasurer under subsection (a) for the
- 14 purpose of deleting the names of confidential informants or
- 15 protecting an ongoing criminal investigation or prosecution
- 16 conducted by Federal, State or local government agencies.
- 17 Section 4. Effective date.
- 18 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
