- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for commercial driver's license
- 3 qualification standards.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1607(d) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1607. Commercial driver's license qualification standards.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (d) Commercial driver learner's permit.--
- 11 (1) The department shall issue a commercial driver
- learner's permit in accordance with section 1505 (relating to
- 13 learners' permits).
- 14 (2) A commercial driver learner's permit is required for
- the addition of endorsements and the removal of restrictions
- 16 established under this chapter, including those established
- 17 by regulation.

- 1 (3) Before a person may take the examination for a commercial driver's license, the person must have held a 2 <u>learner's permit for 30 days for the class of vehicle the</u> 3 person intends to drive and the requisite endorsements. 4
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 5
