## A RESOLUTION

Proclaiming March 1 as Saint David's Day to be observed throughout this Commonwealth.

WHEREAS, During the $19 t h$ Century, large numbers of people from Wales settled in Pennsylvania seeking employment in every field of industry and commerce; and

WHEREAS, Today millions of Americans proudly proclaim their Welsh descent; and

WHEREAS, The traditions and heritage of the Welsh have enriched the culture and fabric of our society; and WHEREAS, Revolutionary War financier Robert Morris, former Chief Justice of the Pennsylvania Supreme Court Benjamin R. Jones, current Federal Circuit Court Justice William Hutchinson
and former Governor Arthur James (1939-1943), among other men of
note, are all Pennsylvanians of Welsh descent; and
WHEREAS, March 1 is traditionally observed by Welshmen as
Saint David's Day to mark the life of Saint David, the patron
saint of Wales; therefore be it
RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives proclaim March 1
as Saint David's Day to be observed throughout this
Commonwealth.
