A RESOLUTION

1 Designating April 8, 2002, as "Pennsylvania Farm Bureau Day."

2 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Farm Bureau, formerly Pennsylvania
3 Farmers' Association, was created on November 24, 1950, to
4 provide Pennsylvania farmers and rural citizens with a strong
5 voice in government; and

6 WHEREAS, This organization represents over 28,063 farm and
7 rural families and has 54 county farm bureau organizations that
8 are active in 61 counties in this Commonwealth; and

1 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Farm Bureau continues to be a
2 strong voice for agricultural industry at the national, State
3 and local levels; and

4 WHEREAS, The agricultural industry and all the residents of
5 this Commonwealth benefit from the effort of the Pennsylvania
6 Farm Bureau; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate April
8 8, 2002, as "Pennsylvania Farm Bureau Day."
