## A RESOLUTION

Declaring June 20, 2002, as "National Service Day" in Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, Efforts have begun on a grass-roots campaign to encourage local communities throughout this great country to join them in commemorating "National Service Day"; and

WHEREAS, National service entails more than volunteerism; and
WHEREAS, National service encompasses a compact between a community and its residents to engage in a communally beneficial relationship; and

WHEREAS, National service promotes the ethic of mutual responsibility in which government has an obligation to create opportunities for its citizens, with citizens having an obligation to give something back; and

WHEREAS, National service strengthens the bonds of citizenship and patriotism; and

WHEREAS, National service is in keeping with President Andrew Jackson's credo of "equal opportunity for all, special privilege
