1 Designating a portion of SR 11 in Salem Township, Luzerne
2 County, as Salem Boulevard ~~AND~~; A PORTION OF US ROUTE 119 IN <—
3 INDIANA COUNTY AS THE PATRICK J. STAPLETON MEMORIAL HIGHWAY
4 ~~AND~~; A PORTION OF STATE ROUTE 413 BETWEEN ITS INTERSECTION <—
5 WITH STATE ROUTE 13 AND THE PENNSYLVANIA TURNPIKE IN BRISTOL
6 TOWNSHIP, BUCKS COUNTY, AS VETERANS HIGHWAY; A SECTION OF SR
7 1011 IN CLEARFIELD, CAMERON AND ELK COUNTIES AS THE QUEHANNA
8 HIGHWAY; THE NORTH GEORGE STREET BRIDGE IN THE CITY OF YORK,
9 YORK COUNTY, AS THE GOVERNOR GEORGE M. LEADER BRIDGE; AND THE <—
10 RAMP FROM THE I-279S HOV LANE TO ANDERSON STREET IN ALLEGHENY
11 COUNTY AS CIGNA'S WAY.

12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
13 hereby enacts as follows:

14 Section 1. Salem Boulevard in Salem Township, Luzerne County.

15 ~~(a) Designation. The section (A) DESIGNATION.--THE PORTION~~ <—
16 of SR 11 in Salem Township, Luzerne County, from the boundary <—
17 line between Shickshinny Borough, Luzerne County, and Salem <—
18 Township, Luzerne County, to Bomboy Lane in Salem Township, <—
19 Luzerne County, is hereby designated AS Salem Boulevard. <—

3 SECTION 2. PATRICK J. STAPLETON MEMORIAL HIGHWAY IN INDIANA <—
4 COUNTY.

5 (A) DESIGNATION.--THE PORTION OF US ROUTE 119 IN INDIANA <—
6 COUNTY BETWEEN US ROUTE 422 AND US ROUTE 22 IS HEREBY DESIGNATED
7 AS THE PATRICK J. STAPLETON MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

8 (B) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL, IN <—
9 APPROPRIATE LOCATIONS, ERECT AND MAINTAIN SIGNS DISPLAYING THE
10 NAME DESIGNATED UNDER SUBSECTION (A).

15 SECTION 3. VETERANS HIGHWAY IN BRISTOL TOWNSHIP, BUCKS COUNTY. <—

16 (A) DESIGNATION.--THE PORTION OF STATE ROUTE 413 BETWEEN ITS
17 INTERSECTION WITH STATE ROUTE 13 AND THE PENNSYLVANIA TURNPIKE
18 IN BRISTOL TOWNSHIP, BUCKS COUNTY, IS HEREBY DESIGNATED AS
19 VETERANS HIGHWAY.

20 (B) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL, IN
21 APPROPRIATE LOCATIONS, ERECT AND MAINTAIN SIGNS DISPLAYING THE
22 NAME DESIGNATED UNDER SUBSECTION (A).

23 SECTION 4. QUEHANNA HIGHWAY.

24 THE SECTION OF STATE ROUTE 1011 THAT RUNS FROM ROUTE 879 NEAR
25 KARTHAUS, IN CLEARFIELD COUNTY THROUGH THE QUEHANNA WILD AREA IN
26 CAMERON AND ELK COUNTIES AND ENDS AT STATE ROUTE 555 AT MEDIX
27 RUN IN ELK COUNTY, IS DESIGNATED AND SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE
28 QUEHANNA HIGHWAY.

29 SECTION 4 5. THE GOVERNOR GEORGE M. LEADER BRIDGE IN THE CITY <—
30 OF YORK, YORK COUNTY.

1 (A) DESIGNATION.--THE BRIDGE NOW KNOWN AS THE NORTH GEORGE
2 STREET BRIDGE ON STATE ROUTE 181 IN THE CITY OF YORK, YORK
3 COUNTY, IS HEREBY DESIGNATED AND SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE GOVERNOR
4 GEORGE M. LEADER BRIDGE. <—

5 (B) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT, IN <—
6 APPROPRIATE LOCATIONS, AND MAINTAIN APPROPRIATE SIGNS DISPLAYING
7 THE NAME ~~OF THE BRIDGE~~ DESIGNATED UNDER SUBSECTION (A). <—
8 SECTION 6. EXIT RAMP FROM I-279S. <—

9 (A) DESIGNATION.--THE EXIT RAMP FROM THE INTERSTATE 279S
10 HIGH OCCUPANCY VEHICLE, OR HOV, LANE TO ANDERSON STREET IN
11 ALLEGHENY COUNTY IS HEREBY DESIGNATED AND SHALL BE KNOWN AS
12 CIGNA'S WAY.

13 (B) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL, IN
14 APPROPRIATE LOCATIONS, ERECT AND MAINTAIN SIGNS DISPLAYING THE
15 NAME DESIGNATED UNDER SUBSECTION (A).
16 Section ~~2-5~~ 7. Effective date. <—
