AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for sale and  
3 transfer of firearms and for duties of the Pennsylvania State  
4 Police relating to guns.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 6111 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania  
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:  
9 § 6111. Sale or transfer of firearms.

11 (b.1) Ammunition.--Any person that sells ammunition for a  
12 firearm, pistol, revolver, rifle or shotgun shall make a report  
13 to the Pennsylvania State Police of all of the following:

14 (1) Description of the purchase, including type and  
15 quantity.

16 (2) Name and address of purchaser.

17 (3) Date of purchase.

2 adding a paragraph to read:

3   § 6111.1.   Pennsylvania State Police.

5       (b)   Duty of Pennsylvania State Police.--

7       (5)   The Pennsylvania State Police shall establish and  
8 maintain a registry of reports received under section  
9 6111(b.1).
