AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for sale and transfer of firearms and for duties of the Pennsylvania State Police relating to guns.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 6111 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:

§ 6111. Sale or transfer of firearms.
```

(b.1) Ammunition.--Any person that sells ammunition for a firearm, pistol, revolver, rifle or shotgun shall make a report to the Pennsylvania State Police of all of the following:
(1) Description of the purchase, including type and quantity.
(2) Name and address of purchaser.
(3) Date of purchase. * * *

Section 2. Section 6111.1(b) of Title 18 is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
§ 6111.1. Pennsylvania State Police.
(b) Duty of Pennsylvania State Police.--
(5) The Pennsylvania State Police shall establish and maintain a registry of reports received under section Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
