## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of 2 3 scattering rubbish. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 6501(b)(1) AND (D)(1) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is ARE amended to read: 8 § 6501. Scattering rubbish. 9 10 (b) Penalty.--(1) A person who violates subsection (a)(1) or (2) is 11 12 quilty of a summary offense for the first offense and upon 13 conviction thereof shall be sentenced to: (i) pay a fine of not less than [\$50] \$250 nor more 14 than [\$300] \$500 [or to];

(ii) imprisonment for not more than 90 days[, or

7	(1) PROPERTY SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE UNDER THIS SECTION	
8	MAY BE SEIZED BY THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY UPON PROCESS	
9	ISSUED BY ANY COURT OF COMMON PLEAS HAVING JURISDICTION OVER	
10	THE PROPERTY. WHEN A WASTE TRANSPORTATION VEHICLE OR A WASTE	
11	TRAILER REGULATED UNDER 27 PA.C.S. § 6204 (RELATING TO WASTE	
12	TRANSPORTATION SAFETY PROGRAM) IS FORFEITED IN ACCORDANCE	
13	WITH THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION	
14	SHALL BE NOTIFIED AND IT SHALL CONDUCT A COMPLIANCE HISTORY	
15	REVIEW OF THE WASTE TRANSPORTER.
