AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, providing for a disability sign program to reduce
3 obstruction of certain driveways during snow removal by the
4 Department of Transportation.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Chapter 80 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read:

14 (a) General rule.--The department shall establish or
15 administer a program that permits persons with disabilities and
16 whose principal residences abut a State highway to apply for a
17 standardized sign that those persons may post on the property on
18 which such principal residences are situated. The department

1 shall, whenever possible, attempt to minimize the blocking of
2 driveways of properties so posted with snow that is removed by
3 the department from State highways.

4 (b) Application.--Any person with a disability may apply to
5 the department for a disability snow removal sign under this
6 section. In order for the department to approve the application,
7 the application must:

8 (1) Be submitted by a person who satisfies the criteria
9 for a disability plate and placard under section 1338(a)(1)
10 through (9) (relating to person with disability plate and
11 placard) on a standardized application form developed by the
12 department.

13 (2) Include a statement from a physician or police
14 officer that satisfies the requirements of section 1338(c)(1)
15 or (3).

16 (3) Include payment of a \$10 fee.

17 (c) Duration and removal.--

18 (1) A disability snow removal sign issued under this
19 section shall be valid from the date of issuance through May
20 1.

21 (2) A person with a disability to whom a disability snow
22 removal sign has been issued under this section shall remove
23 the sign by November 1 of the year in which the disability
24 snow removal sign expires.

25 (d) Reissuance.--A person with a disability to whom a
26 disability snow removal sign has been issued by the department
27 and that has expired shall be entitled, in the following year,
28 to receive a new disability snow removal sign provided that the
29 person satisfies subsection (b)(1) and (2). The department may
30 not charge a fee for the reissuance of a disability snow removal

1 sign under this subsection.

2 (e) Regulations.--The department shall promulgate such rules
3 and regulations as necessary to administer this section.

4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
