## AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 21, 1957 (P.L.390, No.212), entitled "An act requiring certain records of the Commonwealth and its 2 3 political subdivisions and of certain authorities and other 4 agencies performing essential governmental functions, to be open for examination and inspection by citizens of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; authorizing such citizens under 6 7 certain conditions to make extracts, copies, photographs or photostats of such records; and providing for appeals to the courts of common pleas, "further defining "public record." 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. The definition of "public record" in section 1 of 13 the act of June 21, 1957 (P.L.390, No.212), referred to as the Right-to-Know Law, amended June 29, 2002 (P.L.663, No.100), is 14 amended to read: 15 Definitions. 16 Section 1. 17 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall 18 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

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21 "Public record." Any account, voucher or contract dealing

context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 1 with the receipt or disbursement of funds by an agency or its
- 2 acquisition, use or disposal of services or of supplies,
- 3 materials, equipment or other property and any minute, order or
- 4 decision by an agency fixing the personal or property rights,
- 5 privileges, immunities, duties or obligations of any person or
- 6 group of persons: Provided, That the term "public records" shall
- 7 not mean any report, communication or other paper, the
- 8 publication of which would disclose the institution, progress or
- 9 result of an investigation undertaken by an agency in the
- 10 performance of its official duties, except those reports filed
- 11 by agencies pertaining to safety and health in industrial
- 12 plants; it shall not include any record, document, material,
- 13 exhibit, pleading, report, memorandum or other paper, access to
- 14 or the publication of which is prohibited, restricted or
- 15 forbidden by statute law or order or decree of court, or which
- 16 would operate to the prejudice or impairment of a person's
- 17 reputation or personal security, or which would result in the
- 18 loss by the Commonwealth or any of its political subdivisions or
- 19 commissions or State or municipal authorities of Federal funds,
- 20 excepting therefrom however the record of any conviction for any
- 21 criminal act[.]; it shall not include a military discharge form
- 22 used by the Department of Defense and that is filed at a court
- 23 of common pleas by a veteran upon the veteran's discharge from
- 24 <u>active duty.</u>
