12	Section 1. The act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130),

15	Section 415. Acceptance of Gratuities Prohibited(a) No
16	county elected official, employe, agent or any campaign
17	committee or political action committee associated with any of
18	them shall accept any gift, contribution, loan or any other item
19	of monetary value from a vendor doing business with or for the
20	county. This prohibition shall also apply to an agent or close
21	<u>or familial relation to such vendor.</u>

- 1 (b) Any vendor or vendor associate found guilty of violating
- 2 this section commits an unfair trade practice within the meaning
- 3 of and subject to the provisions of the act of December 17, 1968
- 4 (P.L.1224, No.387), known as the "Unfair Trade Practices and
- 5 <u>Consumer Protection Law.</u>"
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
