AN ACT

1 Repealing the act of May 24, 1881 (P.L.29, No.32), entitled "An
2 act defining the power of boards of directors of sub-district
3 schools, of cities of the second class, to provide for the
4 purchasing of lots of ground, erection of school buildings,
5 and other expenses of maintaining schools in their respective
6 districts, and to borrow money for such purposes."

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. The act of May 24, 1881 (P.L.29, No.32), entitled
10 "An act defining the power of boards of directors of sub-
11 district schools, of cities of the second class, to provide for
12 the purchasing of lots of ground, erection of school buildings,
13 and other expenses of maintaining schools in their respective
14 districts, and to borrow money for such purposes," is repealed.

15 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
