AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for lie detector
- 3 tests.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 7321 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 7321. Lie detector tests.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person is quilty of a misdemeanor of
- 10 the second degree if he requires as a condition for employment
- 11 or continuation of employment that an employee or other
- 12 individual shall take a polygraph test or any form of a
- 13 mechanical or electrical lie detector test.
- 14 (b) Exception. -- The provisions of subsection (a) of this
- 15 section shall not apply to employees or other individuals in the
- 16 field of public law enforcement or who dispense or have access
- 17 to narcotics or dangerous drugs.

- 1 (c) Employer notification requirements.--
- 2 (1) An employee or other individual who is given both
- 3 <u>verbal and written notification of his right to refuse to</u>
- 4 <u>take a polygraph test or any form of lie detector test may</u>
- 5 <u>voluntarily waive the prohibition in subsection (a).</u>
- 6 (2) An employee or other individual who takes a
- 7 polygraph test or any form of lie detector test shall be
- 8 provided a written report explaining the results of the test.
- 9 (d) Employer retribution prohibited.--An employer may not
- 10 dismiss, reduce the salary or reduce the employee benefits of an
- 11 employee who exercises his right to refuse to take a lie
- 12 <u>detector test.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
