- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further providing for exemption from registration
- 3 fee.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1901(c) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
- 8 § 1901. Exemption of persons, entities and vehicles from fees.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (c) Processing fee in lieu of registration fee.--No
- 11 registration fee shall be charged for vehicles registered by any
- 12 of the following but the department shall charge a fee of \$10 to
- 13 cover the costs of processing for issuing or renewing the
- 14 registration:

- 16 (24) A Supplemental Security Income (SSI) recipient.

- 1 Unless the SSI recipient is physically or mentally incapable
- 2 of driving the vehicle, the SSI recipient shall be the
- principal driver of the vehicle but may from time to time 3
- authorize another person to drive the vehicle in his or her 4
- 5 stead.
