AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for false reports to
3 law enforcement authorities.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 4906 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8 § 4906. False reports to law enforcement authorities.

9 * * *

10 (d) Felony offenses.--Where the information provided relates
11 to an offense graded as a felony, a person commits a felony of
12 the third degree if he:

13 (1) knowingly gives false information to law enforcement
14 authorities with intent to implicate another;

15 (2) reports to law enforcement authorities an offense
16 within their concern knowing that it did not occur; or

17 (3) pretends to furnish such authorities with
18 information relating to an offense when he knows he has no

1 information relating to such offense.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
