б	Section 1. Section 4103 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania

8	§ 4103. Promulgation of vehicle equipment standards.
9	(a) General ruleThe department shall promulgate vehicle
10	equipment standards for vehicles, equipment and devices required
11	under this part. To the maximum extent possible, consistent with
12	safety, the standards shall be expressed in terms of minimum
13	acceptable performance levels, measured against objective
14	testing parameters.
15	(a.1) Collision avoidance systemsIn addition to other
16	safety equipment required under this section and regulations
17	promulgated under it, each motor vehicle offered for sale in
18	this Commonwealth shall be equipped with a collision avoidance

1 <u>system.</u>

2 (b) Applicability of Federal standards.--Federal standards 3 promulgated with respect to the performance of any vehicle or 4 item of equipment shall have the same force and effect as if promulgated by the department under subsection (a) and shall 5 supersede any Commonwealth standard applicable to the same 6 aspect of performance for the vehicle or item of equipment. 7 8 Incorporation of standards by reference.--Subject to the (C) provisions of subsections (a) and (b), applicable standards or 9 10 recommended practices issued by the National Highway Traffic 11 Safety Administration, U.S. Department of Transportation, the Vehicle Equipment Safety Commission, the American National 12 13 Standards Institute, the Society of Automotive Engineers or any other generally recognized standards setting body may be adopted 14 15 by reference, provided that copies of the standards are 16 incorporated in the notice of proposed rule making.

(d) Applicability to certain vehicles.--Vehicle equipment standards contained in this part or promulgated by the department under the authority given in this part shall not apply to a motor vehicle registered as an antique or classic vehicle containing equipment which meets the original manufacturer's specifications.

(e) Extension of standards prohibited.--Vehicle equipment
standards promulgated by the department shall not be extended to
any vehicle which, because of its date of manufacture, is not
required by Federal standards to have the equipment.
Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
