- 10 the free enterprise system but has worked closely with many
- 11 national and international charitable organizations such as the
- 12 American Red Cross, the American Lung Association and the Civil
- 13 Air Patrol on various projects; and
- 14 WHEREAS, SIFE has participated in programs such as
- 15 "Responsible Use of Credit Week," "Make a Difference Day" and
- 16 "Teach a Child about Business Week"; and
