L5	WHEREAS, These programs have saved and will continue to save
L6	millions of dollars in costs as a result of hospitalization and
L7	nursing care facility institutionalization for many individuals
L8	being prevented or delayed because enrollees have been kept
L9	healthy with their needed prescription medications; and
20	WHEREAS, The Federal Government and pharmaceutical companies

- 3 WHEREAS, The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services has
- 4 offered the Department of Aging a Medicare Demonstration Project
- 5 that proposes Medicare cost offsets and savings be used to
- 6 expand enrollment while assessing coordinated care and disease
- 7 management programs with a pharmaceutical benefit; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The Department of Aging has completed an initial
- 9 study that shows a significant savings to the Medicare program
- 10 by pharmaceutical assistance to the elderly through the PACE and
- 11 PACENET programs; therefore be it
