- 1 Declaring that liquor, wine or beer should not be sold in
- 2 supermarkets, drug stores or chain stores.
- 3 WHEREAS, The State liquor control system, established to
- 4 encourage moderate consumption, has succeeded in that goal; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board State store
- 6 system has generated more than \$9 billion of reliable revenue to
- 7 fund State programs without promoting the sale of alcohol;

- 10 supermarkets, drug stores or chain stores in this Commonwealth.
