## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the week of January 11 through 17, 2004, as
- 2 "Snowmobile Safety Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The family sport of snowmobiling is enjoyed by more
- 4 than 150,000 men, women and children in this Commonwealth; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Snowmobiling represents a significant element of
- 6 winter tourism in this Commonwealth, generating in excess of
- 7 \$200 million annually to the Commonwealth's economy; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State Snowmobile Association and
- 9 the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources have joined
- 10 together to educate thousands of Pennsylvania's young
- 11 snowmobilers and others in the snowmobiling public regarding

- 1 safe and responsible snowmobiling for more than 35 years; and
- WHEREAS, Employing responsible riding practices, such as
- 3 avoiding alcohol and operating at safe speeds, helps make
- 4 snowmobiling experiences safe and enjoyable; therefore be it
- 5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 6 week of January 11 through 17, 2004, as "Snowmobile Safety
- 7 Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania and, in the interest of safe,
- 8 enjoyable snowmobiling, encourage all snowmobilers to take
- 9 advantage of snowmobile safety programs and through their action
- 10 and example preserve and enhance the family sport of
