AMENDMENTS TO SENATE AMENDMENTS, HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, NOVEMBER 15, 2006

AN ACT

1	Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled
2	"An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the
3	executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the
4	Executive Department thereof and the administrative
5	departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,
б	including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or
7	Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or
8	authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative
9	departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and
10	duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative
11	officers, and of the several administrative departments,
12	boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the
13	Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive
14	and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of
15	certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and
16	other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,
17	and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the
18	number and compensation of the deputies and all other
19	assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and
20	commissions shall be determined," providing for transfers of
21	appropriations and for notice of transfers and loans between
22	funds; extending the time period covered by an application
23	considered for the Merchant Marine World War II Veterans
24	Bonus and the expiration of the Merchant Marine World War II
25	Veterans Bonus Act; providing for State plane logs;
26	establishing the Cardiovascular Disease Advisory Committee
27	and a Statewide stroke database; providing for regulation by
28	political subdivisions of public smoking at certain licensed
29	facilities and reporting by Department of Health on public
30	smoking ordinances; and making inconsistent repeals relating

1 to the Merchant Marine World War II Veterans Bonus Act. 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 3 hereby enacts as follows: 4 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known 5 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding sections to read: 6 Section 626. Transfers of Appropriations. -- The following 7 shall apply to transfers between appropriations of State funds 8 9 regardless of the form the transfer takes: 10 (1) Transfers shall be made only as expressly authorized by 11 law. 12 (2) The Secretary of the Budget shall provide, at least ten 13 days prior to any transfer, written notice of such transfer to 14 the chairman and minority chairman of the Appropriations 15 Committee of the Senate and the chairman and minority chairman 16 of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives. 17 (3) Transfers shall be subject to review for form and 18 legality by the Attorney General in the same manner as deeds, 19 leases and contracts to be executed by Commonwealth agencies as 20 provided in section 204(f) of the act of October 15, 1980 21 (P.L.950, No.164), known as the "Commonwealth Attorneys Act." 22 (4) A copy of the approval from the Attorney General shall 23 be submitted to the State Treasurer with the request for 24 transfer. 25 (5) Agreements between agencies or other documents providing 26 for transfers between appropriations of State funds shall be 27 deemed public records for the purposes of the act of June 21, 28 1957 (P.L.390, No.212), referred to as the Right-to-Know Law. Section 627. Inter-Fund Transfers and Loans. -- For transfers 29 30 between funds proposed to be executed pursuant to the authority

2	entitled "An act authorizing the State Treasurer under certain	
3	conditions to transfer sums of money between the General Fund	
4	and certain funds and subsequent transfers of equal sums between

б	transfers," and for loans from the Motor License Fund proposed	
7	to be executed pursuant to section 11 of Article VIII of the	
8	Constitution of Pennsylvania, the Secretary of the Budget shall	
9	<u>provide, at least ten days prior to any transfer or loan,</u>	
10	written notice of such transfer or loan to the chairman and	
11	minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate	
12	and the chairman and minority chairman of the Appropriations	
13	Committee of the House of Representatives.	
14	Section 1418. Extension of Dates for Service, Application	
15	and Expiration for the Merchant Marine World War II Bonus(a)	
16	Notwithstanding the specific time periods set forth in the	
17	definition of "Merchant Marine veteran who served during World	
18	War II" in section 2 and section 4 of the act of April 12, 2006	
19	(P.L.67, No.22), known as the "Merchant Marine World War II	
20	<u>Veterans Bonus Act," the Adjutant General of the Pennsylvania</u>	
21	Department of Military and Veterans Affairs shall accept any	
22	submitted Federal DD-214 covering the time period from December	
23	<u>7, 1941, through December 31, 1946.</u>	
24	(b) Notwithstanding section 4(c) of the Merchant Marine	
25	World War II Veterans Bonus Act, the Adjutant General of the	
26	Pennsylvania Department of Military and Veterans Affairs shall	
27	accept and consider any application submitted under the	
28	<u>"Merchant Marine World War II Veterans Bonus Act," until June</u>	
29	30, 2007, covering the time period from December 7, 1941,	
30	through December 31, 1946.

1	(c) Notwithstanding section 11 of the Merchant Marine World
2	<u>War II Veterans Bonus Act, the expiration date for that act</u>
3	<u>shall be June 30, 2008.</u>
4	(d) The definition of "Merchant Marine veteran who served
5	during World War II" in section 2 and sections 4(a) and (c) and
6	<u>11 of the "Merchant Marine World War II Veterans Bonus Act" are</u>
7	repealed insofar as those provisions are inconsistent with the
8	provisions of this section.
9	<u>Section 2016. State Plane Logs. (a) The Department of</u> <-
10	Transportation shall prepare a daily log of all travel on
11	Commonwealth owned planes and other aircraft other than travel
12	for military or law enforcement purposes.
13	(b) The daily log shall include, at a minimum:
14	(1) The date of travel.
15	(2) The time of travel.
16	(3) The origin and destination of the trip.
17	(4) The name and title of each passenger.
18	(5) The specific reason for the travel.
19	(c) No later than fourteen (14) days after the date of each
20	log, the department shall post that log on a publicly accessible
21	Internet website.
22	Section 2126. Cardiovascular Disease Advisory Committee
23	(a) The Cardiovascular Disease Advisory Committee is
24	established.
25	(b) The Cardiovascular Disease Advisory Committee shall:
26	(1) Advise the department on how to raise awareness on
27	prevention of cardiovascular disease and stroke among the
28	public, the health care community and policymakers using all
29	<u>available data.</u>
30	(2) Identify evidence-based best practice education

1	strategies for the public to identify risk factors associated
2	with the cardiovascular disease and stroke and to identify
3	symptoms at onset.
4	(3) Identify and review evidence-based best practice health
5	promotion and disease prevention strategies related to
6	cardiovascular disease and stroke for implementation in
7	Pennsylvania, with the goal of reducing death and long-term
8	<u>disability among Pennsylvanians.</u>
9	(4) Identify limitations and problems associated with
10	existing laws, regulations, programs and services related to
11	cardiovascular disease and stroke and propose feasible changes.
12	(5) Examine evidence-based current and alternative treatment
13	options available for treating different types of cardiovascular
14	disease and stroke.
15	(6) Review data collected by the Department of Health
16	pursuant to section 2127 to identify areas of improved outcomes,
17	including reduced secondary stroke events.
18	(7) Identify any additional issues that come before the
19	advisory committee.
20	(c) (1) The Cardiovascular Disease Advisory Committee shall
21	consist of a maximum of 16 members, including representatives
22	from the Department of Aging, the Department of Health, the
23	Insurance Department and the Department of Public Welfare.
24	(2) The Secretary of Health shall appoint one representative
25	from each of the following fields to serve on the advisory
26	<u>committee:</u>
27	(i) Board-certified cardiac surgeon.
28	(ii) Board-certified neurologist.
29	(iii) Public health professional.
30	(iv) Licensed dietician.

1 (v) Registered nurse with expertise in cardiovascular

2 <u>disease.</u>

3 (vi) Hospital administrator.

4 <u>(vii) Disparate community.</u>

5 <u>(viii) Emergency medical services community.</u>

6 (ix) Organization representing the rural population.

7 (x) Board certified primary care provider that is a

8 physician specializing in either family practice or internal

9 <u>medicine.</u>

10 <u>(xi) Nonprofit health service plan.</u>

11 (xii) Voluntary organization that addresses cardiovascular

12 <u>disease.</u>

13 (d) The term of the advisory committee members shall be two 14 years from the respective date of their appointment, except that 15 the initial appointments shall be made in such a manner so that six members appointed under subsection (c)(2) shall be appointed 16 17 for a term of two years, and six members be appointed for a term 18 of one year. A member shall hold office for the term of his 19 appointment and until a successor has been appointed and 20 qualified. All vacancies shall be filled for the balance of the 21 unexpired term in the same manner as the original appointment. A 22 member of the advisory committee is eligible for reappointment 23 by the Secretary of Health, contingent upon diligent attendance at meetings of the board. 24 25 (e) The Secretary of Health or his designee will serve as 26 the chairperson of the advisory committee and may select a 27 secretary, who need not be a member of the advisory committee. 28 (f) Members who are not employees of State government shall be reimbursed for travel and other actual expenses reasonably 29 incurred in the performance of their duties. 30 20050H0471B4923 – б –

1	(g) The advisory committee shall meet no less than twice
2	annually. Nine members of the advisory committee shall
3	constitute a quorum for the purpose of exercising all of the
4	powers of the advisory committee. A vote of the majority of the
5	members present shall be sufficient for all actions of the
6	advisory committee.
7	(h) This section shall take expire December 31, 2011.
8	Section 2127. Stroke Data CollectionThe Department of
9	<u>Health shall establish and maintain a Statewide stroke database</u>
10	that compiles stroke care information and statistics relating to
11	strokes in this Commonwealth and shall make information and
12	statistics available to the public on the Department of Health's
13	Internet website. The Department of Health shall not be required
14	to collect data for this database that is already required to be
15	collected by the Pennsylvania Health Care Cost Containment
16	Council. To every extent possible, the Department of Health
17	shall coordinate with the Pennsylvania Health Care Cost
18	Containment Council to avoid duplication and redundancy. In
19	establishing this database the Department of Health shall use
20	its annual survey of hospitals to collect aggregate information
21	by hospital on the Joint Commission of Accreditation of
22	Healthcare Organizations Primary Stroke Centers Standardized
23	Stroke Measure Set used, as a measurement of best practice for
24	<u>stroke care.</u>
25	Section 2128. Public Smoking at Licensed Facilities and <
26	Reporting. (a) Licensed facilities defined under 4 Pa.C.S. §
27	1103 (relating to definitions) shall be subject to public
28	smoking ordinances, rules and regulations adopted by any
29	political subdivision of this Commonwealth.
30	(b) The Department of Health shall collect information on

the number of political subdivisions that have adopted public 1 2 <u>smoking ordinances, rules and regulations and shall report the</u> 3 information annually to the General Assembly. Section 2. This act shall take effect as follows: 4 (1) The addition of sections 626, 627 and 1418 of the 5 6 act shall take effect immediately. 7 (2) This section shall take effect immediately. (3) The remainder of this act shall take effect in 60 8 days. 9
