AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, providing for certain veterans plates.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 6 Statutes is amended by adding sections to read:
- 7 § 1362. Operation Iraqi Freedom veterans plate.
- 8 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the
- 9 liberation or occupation of Iraq, accompanied by a fee of \$20,
- 10 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by
- 11 documentation as the department shall require, the department
- 12 <u>shall issue to the person a special registration plate</u>
- 13 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who
- 14 <u>is a veteran of Operation Iraqi Freedom.</u>

- 1 § 1363. Operation Enduring Freedom veterans plate.
- 2 <u>Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the</u>
- 3 <u>liberation or occupation of Afghanistan, accompanied by a fee of</u>
- 4 \$20, which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee
- 5 and by documentation as the department shall require, the
- 6 <u>department shall issue to the person a special registration</u>
- 7 plate designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a
- 8 person who is a veteran of Operation Enduring Freedom.
- 9 § 1364. Special plates for veterans.
- 10 Upon application of any person who is an honorably discharged
- 11 <u>veteran of the armed forces of the United States, or a reserve</u>
- 12 component of the armed forces as defined in 51 Pa.C.S. § 7301
- 13 (relating to definitions), accompanied by a fee of \$20 which
- 14 shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by such
- 15 <u>documentation</u> as the department shall require, the department
- 16 <u>shall issue to the person a special registration plate</u>
- 17 <u>designating the vehicle as belonging to a person who is a</u>
- 18 veteran of the armed forces of the United States.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
