AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further providing for content of driver's license.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 1510(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 6 Consolidated Statutes, amended November 30, 2004 (P.L.1474,
- 7 No.188), is amended to read:
- 8 § 1510. Issuance and content of driver's license.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- The department shall, upon payment of the
- 10 required fee, issue to every qualified applicant a driver's
- 11 license indicating the type or general class of vehicles the
- 12 licensee is authorized to drive and any endorsements or
- 13 restrictions, which license shall contain a distinguishing

- 1 number assigned by the department to the licensee, the actual
- 2 name, date of birth, residence address, a color photograph or
- 3 photographic facsimile of the licensee, such other information
- 4 as may be required by the department, and either a facsimile of
- 5 the signature of the licensee or a space upon which the licensee
- 6 shall write his usual signature with pen and ink. Program
- 7 participants in the Address Confidentiality Program under 23
- 8 Pa.C.S. Ch. 67 (relating to domestic and sexual violence victim
- 9 address confidentiality) may use a substitute address designated
- 10 by the Office of Victim Advocate as their address. Personal
- 11 medical data, including blood type, and other information for
- 12 use in an emergency may be included as a part of the license.
- 13 Information other than that required to identify the licensee,
- 14 the distinguishing number and the class of license issued may be
- 15 included in microdata form. Except as provided in subsection
- 16 (f), an applicant shall include his Social Security number on
- 17 his license application, but the Social Security number shall
- 18 not be included on the license. No driver's license shall be
- 19 valid until it has been signed by the licensee.

- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
