AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- 4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto, "further providing for the scholarship
- 6 organization educational improvement tax credit programs.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Sections 2003-B(c) and (d) and 2007-B of the act
- 10 of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School
- 11 Code of 1949, amended December 23, 2003 (P.L.304, No.48), are
- 12 amended to read:
- 13 Section 2003-B. Qualification and application.
- 14 * * *
- 15 (c) Scholarship organizations and pre-kindergarten
- 16 scholarship organizations. -- A scholarship organization or pre-
- 17 kindergarten scholarship organization must certify to the
- 18 department that the organization is eligible to participate in

- 1 the program established under this article[.] and must agree to
- 2 annually report to the department by September 1 of each year,
- 3 on a form to be provided by the department:
- 4 (1) (i) The number of scholarships awarded during the
- 5 <u>previous school year to eligible pre-kindergarten</u>
- 6 students.
- 7 <u>(ii) The total and average amounts of the</u>
- 8 <u>scholarships awarded during the previous school year to</u>
- 9 <u>eligible pre-kindergarten students.</u>
- 10 (iii) The number of scholarships awarded during the
- 11 <u>previous school year to eligible students in grades K-8.</u>
- 12 (iv) The total and average amounts of the
- scholarships awarded during the previous school year to
- eligible students in grades K-8.
- 15 (v) The number of scholarships awarded during the
- previous school year to eliqible students in grades 9-12.
- 17 (vi) The total and average amounts of the
- 18 scholarships awarded during the previous school year to
- 19 eligible students in grades 9-12.
- 20 (vii) To the extent that it is feasible to do so,
- 21 <u>the total number and the total amount of scholarships</u>
- 22 awarded during the previous school year to residents of
- each county in this Commonwealth.
- 24 (2) The department shall prepare sample forms for
- 25 reporting the data required under this subsection, and shall
- 26 <u>annually distribute such sample forms, together with the</u>
- forms on which the reports are required to be made, to each
- 28 <u>listed scholarship organization and pre-kindergarten</u>
- 29 <u>scholarship organization by July 1 of each year. The</u>
- 30 department may not require any other information to be

1	provided by scholarship organizations or pre-kindergarten
2	scholarship organizations, except as expressly authorized in
3	this article.
4	(d) Educational improvement organization
5	(1) An application submitted by an educational
6	improvement organization must describe its proposed
7	innovative educational program or programs in a form
8	prescribed by the department. The department shall consult
9	with the Department of Education as necessary. The department
10	shall review and approve or disapprove the application. $\underline{\text{In}}$
11	order to be eligible to participate in the program
12	established under this article, an educational improvement
13	organization must agree to annually report to the department
14	by September 1 of each year, on a form to be provided by the
15	<u>department:</u>
16	(i) The name of the innovative educational program
17	or programs and award amount or amounts made to those
18	programs during the previous school year.
19	(ii) A description of how each award was utilized
20	during the previous school year with demonstrated or
21	expected innovative educational improvements.
22	(iii) The names of the public schools and school
23	districts where innovative educational programs that
24	received awards during the previous school year were
25	<u>implemented</u> .
26	(iv) To the extent that it is feasible to do so, a
27	listing of the amount awarded during the previous school
28	year for programs at schools and school districts on a
29	county-by-county basis.
30	(2) The department shall prepare sample forms for

- 1 reporting the data required under this subsection, and shall
- 2 <u>annually distribute such sample forms, together with the</u>
- forms on which the reports are required to be made, to each
- 4 <u>listed educational improvement organization by July 1 of each</u>
- 5 year. The department may not require any other information to
- be provided by educational improvement organizations, except
- 7 as expressly authorized in this article.

- 9 Section 2007-B. Lists and reports.
- 10 (a) Annual listing of organizations. -- The Department of
- 11 Revenue shall provide a list of all scholarship organizations,
- 12 pre-kindergarten scholarship organizations and educational
- 13 improvement organizations receiving contributions from business
- 14 firms granted a tax credit under this article to the General
- 15 Assembly by June 30 of each year.
- (b) Contents of annual report. -- The department, in
- 17 consultation with the Department of Education and the Department
- 18 of Revenue, shall report, by December 31 of each year, the
- 19 following information to the General Assembly:
- 20 (1) The total number of scholarships awarded during the
- 21 <u>previous school year to eligible pre-kindergarten students.</u>
- 22 (2) The total and average amounts of scholarships
- awarded during the previous school year to eligible pre-
- 24 <u>kindergarten students.</u>
- 25 (3) The total number of scholarships awarded during the
- 26 <u>previous school year to eliqible students in grades K-8.</u>
- 27 (4) The total and average amounts of scholarships
- 28 <u>awarded during the previous school year to eligible students</u>
- in grades K-8.
- 30 (5) The total number of scholarships awarded during the

1 previous school year to eligible students in grades 9-12. 2 (6) The total and average amounts of scholarships 3 awarded during the previous school year to eligible students 4 in grades 9-12. 5 (7) The total number and the total amounts of all scholarships awarded during the previous school year to 6 7 residents of each county in this Commonwealth. (8) The names of all educational improvement 8 9 organizations making awards during the previous school year. the names of all innovative educational programs receiving 10 such awards and the total amount awarded by each educational 11 12 improvement organization. 13 (9) The names of the public schools and school districts where innovative educational programs that received awards 14 during the previous school year were implemented. 15 16 (10) A description of how awards made during the previous school year were utilized in each innovative 17 18 educational program, including demonstrated or expected innovative educational improvements. 19 20 (11) The total number of business firms receiving tax 21 credits under this article during the previous fiscal year. (12) The number of businesses that made total 22 23 contributions, for which they received tax credits under this 2.4 article during the previous fiscal year, of less than 25 \$10,000. (13) The number of businesses that made total 26 27 contributions, for which they received tax credits under this 28 article during the previous fiscal year, of at least \$10,000 29 but not more than \$100,000. (14) The number of businesses that made total 30

- 1 contributions, for which they received tax credits under this
- article during the previous fiscal year, of at least \$100,000 2
- 3 but not more than \$200,000.
- 4 (15) The number of businesses that made total
- 5 contributions, for which they received tax credits under this
- 6 article during the previous fiscal year of \$200,000 or more.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 7
