## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for deferred motor
- 3 vehicle insurance coverage.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 7317 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding subsections to read:
- 8 § 7317. Deferred motor vehicle insurance coverage.
- 9 \* \* \*
- 10 (f) Actions prohibited. -- No insurer shall, because of the
- 11 deferral of insurance coverage provided under this section,
- 12 cancel, nonrenew, impose a surcharge or a rate penalty or remove
- 13 any premium discount on any insurance coverage upon
- 14 reinstatement of the member's coverage.
- 15 (q) Intent.--It is the specific intent of the General
- 16 Assembly to treat individuals subject to this section as if no

- 1 <u>deferral of insurance coverage occurred and insurance coverage</u>
- 2 was not interrupted.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
