## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of
- 3 solicitation of minors to traffic drugs.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 6319 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 6319. Solicitation and use of minors to traffic drugs.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person 18 years of age or older
- 10 commits a felony of the second degree if he [solicits a person
- 11 who is less than 18 years of age to engage in a violation of
- 12 section 13(a)(14) or (30) of the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233,
- 13 No.64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and
- 14 Cosmetic Act, or delivers or conspires to deliver a controlled
- 15 substance to such a person, intending, knowing or having reason
- 16 to know that the person intends to engage in such a violation
- 17 with the controlled substance.]:

- 1 (1) solicits a person who is under 18 years of age to
- 2 <u>engage in a violation of section 13(a)(14) or (30) of the act</u>
- of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as The Controlled
- 4 <u>Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act;</u>
- 5 (2) delivers or conspires to deliver a controlled
- 6 <u>substance to a person who is under 18 years of age,</u>
- 7 <u>intending, knowing or having reason to know that the person</u>
- 8 <u>intends to engage in a violation of section 13(a)(14) or (30)</u>
- 9 of The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act
- 10 with the controlled substance; or
- 11 (3) receives or conspires to receive a controlled
- 12 <u>substance from a person who is under 18 years of age knowing</u>
- or having reason to know that the person is engaging in a
- violation of section 13(a)(14) or (30) of The Controlled
- 15 <u>Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act.</u>
- 16 (b) Drug-free school zone.--A person violating subsection
- 17 (a) commits a felony of the first degree if he intends, knows or
- 18 has reason to know that the person under 18 years of age intends
- 19 to violate section 13(a)(14) or (30) of The Controlled
- 20 Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act in a drug-free school
- 21 zone.
- 22 (c) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "drug-
- 23 free school zone" means the area within 1,000 feet of the real
- 24 property on which is located a public, private or parochial
- 25 school or a college or university. The term also includes a
- 26 school bus or the area within 500 feet of a school bus stop.
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
