AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, further providing for junior driver's license.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Section 1503(c) Title 75 of the Pennsylvania  
6 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding paragraphs to read:

7 § 1503. Persons ineligible for licensing; license issuance to  
8 minors; junior driver's license.

10 (c) Junior driver's license.--The department may issue a  
11 junior driver's license to a person 16 or 17 years of age under  
12 rules and regulations adopted by the department and subject to  
13 the provisions of this section. A junior driver's license shall  
14 automatically become a regular driver's license when the junior  
15 driver attains 18 years of age.

17 (2.1) Except as provided in paragraph (2.2), a junior

1 driver may not drive a vehicle with more than one passenger  
2 under 18 years of age.

3 (2.2) With parental or in loco parentis approval, a  
4 junior driver may drive a vehicle with passengers who are  
5 siblings or relatives who live in the same dwelling as the  
6 junior driver.

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
