Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 2 Statutes, providing for protection of children from 3 secondhand smoke. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 5 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 4587. Secondhand smoke. 9 (a) Scope. -- This section applies to all of the following: 10 (1) Passenger cars. (2) Class I trucks. 11 (3) Class II trucks. 12 13 (4) Classic motor vehicles. 14 (5) Antique motor vehicles. 15 (6) Motor homes. (b) Prohibition. -- If a child under eight years of age is in 16 17 a motor vehicle designated in subsection (a), an individual may

not smoke or carry a lighted cigarette, cigar or pipe in that

- 1 motor vehicle.
- (c) Offense. -- An individual who violates this section 2
- commits a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be 3
- 4 sentenced to pay a fine of \$25. The court imposing the fine
- shall transfer the fine to the State Treasurer for deposit in 5
- the fund under section 4582 (relating to Child Passenger 6
- 7 Restraint Fund).
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
