AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for open lewdness.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 5901 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 7 § 5901. Open lewdness.
- 8 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits [a misdemeanor of the
- 9 third degree] an offense if he does any lewd act which he knows
- 10 is likely to be observed by others who would be affronted or
- 11 alarmed.
- 12 <u>(b) Grading.--</u>
- 13 (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2), an offense
- 14 under this section constitutes a misdemeanor of the third
- 15 <u>degree</u>.
- 16 (2) Where the offense under this section is committed on

- county, municipal or State-owned property, the offense 1
- constitutes a misdemeanor of the second degree. 2
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 3
