AN ACT

- 1 Authorizing and directing the Department of General Services,
- with the approval of the Governor and the Department of
- 3 Military and Veterans Affairs, to grant and convey to the
- 4 Borough of Mansfield certain lands situate in the Borough of
- 5 Mansfield, Tioga County.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Conveyance in Mansfield Borough, Tioga County.
- 9 (a) Authorization. -- The Department of General Services, with
- 10 the approval of the Governor and the Department of Military and
- 11 Veterans Affairs, is authorized and directed on behalf of the
- 12 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to grant and convey to the Borough
- 13 of Mansfield certain land situate in the Borough of Mansfield,
- 14 Tioga County for fair market value as determined by independent
- 15 appraisal.
- 16 (b) Description. -- The property to be conveyed pursuant to
- 17 subsection (a) consists of approximately 1.23 acres and an
- 18 armory building bounded and more particularly described as
- 19 follows:

- 1 BEGINNING at a point at the western edge of the now or late
- 2 Erie Railroad Company right-of-way, the Southeast corner of land
- 3 of the now or late Mansfield Joint School Authority and the
- 4 Northeast corner of land of the now or late Mansfield School
- 5 District, the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence South 77 degrees 50
- 6 minutes West along lands of the now or late Mansfield School
- 7 District, a distance of 273.67 feet to a point, the Southwest
- 8 corner hereof; thence North 13 degrees 30 minutes West along
- 9 lands of the now or late Mansfield Joint School Authority, a
- 10 distance of 252.25 feet to a point, the Northwest corner hereof;
- 11 thence North 76 degrees 30 minutes East along lands of the now
- 12 or late Mansfield Joint School Authority a distance of 153.00
- 13 feet to a point at the western edge of the now or late Erie
- 14 Railroad Company right-of-way, the Northeast corner hereof;
- 15 thence along the said Railroad Company right-of-way, South 27
- 16 degrees 48 minutes East, a distance of 12.00 feet to a point;
- 17 thence South 38 degrees 55 minutes East along said Railroad
- 18 Company right-of-way, a distance of 272.25 feet to a point, the
- 19 place of beginning.
- 20 CONTAINING 1.23 acres more or less.
- 21 (c) Easements. -- The conveyance shall be made under and
- 22 subject to all lawful and enforceable easements, servitudes and
- 23 rights of others, including streets, roadways and rights of any
- 24 telephone, telegraph, water, electric, gas or pipeline
- 25 companies, as well as under the subject to any lawful and
- 26 enforceable estates or tenancies vested in third persons
- 27 appearing of record, for any portion of the land or improvements
- 28 erected on the land.
- 29 (d) Use restriction. -- Any conveyance authorized under this
- 30 section shall be made under and subject to the condition, which

- 1 shall be contained in the deed of conveyance, that no portion of
- 2 the property conveyed shall be used as a licensed facility as
- 3 defined in 4 Pa.C.S. § 1103 (relating to definitions) or any
- 4 other similar type of facility authorized under State law. The
- 5 condition shall be a covenant running with the land and shall be
- 6 binding upon the Grantee, its successors and assigns. If the
- 7 Grantee, its successors or assigns, permits any portion of the
- 8 property authorized to be conveyed in this section to be used in
- 9 violation of this subsection, the title shall immediately revert
- 10 to and revest in the Grantor.
- 11 (e) Deed.--The deed of conveyance shall be by Special
- 12 Warranty Deed and shall be executed by the Secretary of General
- 13 Services in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 14 (f) Costs and fees.--Costs and fees incidental to this
- 15 conveyance shall be borne by the Grantee.
- 16 (q) Proceeds. -- The proceeds from the conveyance shall be
- 17 deposited in the State Treasury Armory Fund.
- 18 (h) Alternate disposition. -- In the event that this
- 19 conveyance is not executed within 12 months of the effective
- 20 date of this section, the property may be disposed of in
- 21 accordance with section 2406-A of the act of April 9, 1929
- 22 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929.
- 23 Section 2. Effective date.
- 24 This act shall take effect immediately.
