- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for driver's license issuance to
- 3 minors.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1503(a)(7) of Title 75 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is
- 8 amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 9 § 1503. Persons ineligible for licensing; license issuance to
- 10 minors; junior driver's license.
- 11 (a) Persons ineligible for licensing. -- The department shall
- 12 not issue a driver's license to, or renew the driver's license
- 13 of, any person:
- 14 * * *
- 15 (7) Who is under 18 years of age except in accordance
- with subsections (b), (b.1) and (c).

1	(b.1) License issuance to certain minor volunteers
2	(1) The department shall issue a driver's license to a
3	minor who is 16 or 17 years of age who:
4	(i) Is a member of a volunteer fire company,
5	volunteer fire department or volunteer ambulance,
6	paramedic or other rescue squad and is certified by the
7	minor's fire chief or supervisor as having been active
8	and in good standing with the volunteer organization for
9	a continuous period of two years immediately preceding
LO	the certification.
L1	(ii) Has successfully completed a driver's training
L2	course approved by the department.
L3	(iii) Has met the requirements of section 1505 and
L4	passed the examination under section 1505(e).
L5	(2) The driver's license of the minor shall be canceled,
L6	and the minor shall surrender the license in a manner
L7	prescribed by the department upon termination of the minor's
L8	volunteer status under paragraph (1)(i), whereupon the
L9	department shall issue a junior driver's license to the
20	minor.
21	(3) In addition to the other provisions of this title
22	relating to penalties or to the suspension or revocation of
23	operating privileges, in the event that a minor driver under
24	this subsection is involved in an accident reportable under
25	section 3746(a) for which the minor driver is primarily
26	responsible in the opinion of the department or is convicted
27	of any violation of this title, the department may cancel the
28	driver's license of the minor driver, in which case the minor
29	driver shall surrender the license in a manner prescribed by
30	the department, and the department shall issue a junior
