One-half of the revenue shall be paid to municipalities as designated in subparagraph (ii) in the 2 3 same ratio provided in section 4 of the act of June 1, 4 1956 (P.L.1944, No.655), relating to partial allocation 5 of liquid fuels and fuel use tax proceeds. (ii) Only municipalities that provide local police 6 services through a municipal police department, 7 participation in a regional police department or 8 9 contracts with other municipal or regional police for 10 police services may receive revenue under subparagraph 11 (i). (iii) When one-half of the revenue under 12 13 subparagraph (i) is not payable to a municipality because 14 the municipality does not meet the qualifications of subparagraph (ii), that amount shall be placed into a 15 16 restricted receipts account within the Motor License Fund 17 and designated as the Assigned Vehicle and Equipment 18 Upgrade Account. Funds in the Assigned Vehicle and 19 Equipment Upgrade Account shall be annually appropriated 20 to the Pennsylvania State Police for the purpose of 21 providing assigned vehicles to State troopers and 22 upgrading equipment as necessary. 23 * * * Section 2.
