AN ACT

- 1 Requiring the owners and operators of retail service stations to
- 2 provide air hoses for public use; providing for enforcement
- 3 by the State Bureau of Ride and Measurement Standards in the
- 4 Department of Agriculture; and imposing a civil penalty.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Short title.
- 8 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Air Hoses for
- 9 Fuel Economy Act.
- 10 Section 2. Legislative findings.
- 11 (1) The Department of Environmental Protection estimates
- that having poorly inflated tires wastes approximately 3% of
- 13 fuel used in motor vehicles.
- 14 (2) The purpose of this legislation is to aid in fuel
- 15 economy by making it easier and cost free to maintain proper
- 16 air inflation.
- 17 Section 3. Definitions.
- 18 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall

- 1 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 2 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 3 "Bureau." The State Bureau of Ride and Measurement Standards
- 4 in the Department of Agriculture.
- 5 "Retail service station." A person, firm or corporation
- 6 maintaining a place of business where gasoline or other vehicle
- 7 fuel is sold and delivered into the tanks of motor vehicles,
- 8 boats, motorboats or watercraft.
- 9 Section 4. Requirements.
- 10 (a) General rule.--
- 11 (1) A retail service station owner or operator must make
- available for public use a functioning air hose with a built-
- in means to check tire air pressure.
- 14 (2) Except as set forth in subsection (b), a retail
- 15 service station owner or operator may not require payment or
- 16 the use of a coin or token to operate an air hose.
- 17 (b) Exception.--A retail service station owner or operator
- 18 that maintains an air hose that meets the requirements of
- 19 subsection (a)(1) on the retail service station premises on the
- 20 effective date of this act may offer tokens at no cost to
- 21 customers for their use in operating the air hose. The retail
- 22 service station owner or operator shall display at the place
- 23 where the air hose is situated a notice stating that tokens are
- 24 available free of charge.
- 25 Section 5. Repair or replacement.
- 26 If an air hose is not operable and in need of repair or
- 27 replacement, a retail service station owner or operator shall
- 28 post an out-of-order notice at the place where the air hose is
- 29 situated. The retail service station owner or operator must
- 30 effect the repair or replacement within 30 days from the date

- 1 the need for repair or replacement becomes known to the owner or
- 2 operator.
- 3 Section 6. Civil penalty.
- 4 The bureau may assess a civil penalty of \$50 for each day of
- 5 violation of this act by a retail service station owner or
- 6 operator.
- 7 Section 7. Enforcement.
- 8 The bureau shall enforce the provisions of this act.
- 9 Section 8. Effective date.
- 10 This act shall take effect in 90 days.
