A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing February 2006 as "Women's Heart Month" in
- 2 Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, February has been designated as "American Heart
- 4 Month"; and
- 5 WHEREAS, One out of every three women in the United States is
- 6 affected by heart disease -- the number one killer of women in the
- 7 nation--but there remain far fewer educational and behavioral
- 8 programs for women's heart health than for other diseases; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The Working Hearts coalition and its partners,
- 10 celebrating their first anniversary, are making tremendous

- 1 efforts to address this crisis by promoting a public health
- 2 campaign, "Strong Women/Strong Hearts," and by serving as a
- 3 catalyst for improving women's heart health awareness, education
- 4 and research; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Working Hearts amplifies the power of its local
- 6 members in the Pittsburgh region and their national counterparts
- 7 and encourages every woman to improve her own heart health
- 8 through better nutrition, physical activity, screenings and
- 9 stress management; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 11 month of February 2006 as "Women's Heart Month," during which
- 12 all women and their families are urged to learn about women's
- 13 heart health and the importance of heart-healthy behavior.
