AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of 3 firearms not to be carried without a license and for license 4 to carry firearm. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 6106(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: § 6106. Firearms not to be carried without a license. 10 (b) Exceptions. -- The provisions of subsection (a) shall not 11 12 apply to: 13 (14) (16) Any person holding a license in accordance 14 15 with section 6109(f)(3). 16

Section 2. Section 6109(f)(1) of Title 18 is amended and the

- 4 (f) Term of license.--
- 5 (1) A license to carry a firearm issued under subsection
- 6 (e) shall be valid throughout this Commonwealth for a period
- 7 of five years unless <u>extended under paragraph (3) or sooner</u>
- 8 revoked.

- 10 (3) Notwithstanding paragraph (1) or any other provision
- of law to the contrary, a license to carry a firearm that is
- held by a member of the United States Armed Forces or the
- 13 <u>Pennsylvania National Guard on Federal active duty and</u>
- deployed overseas that is scheduled to expire during the
- 15 <u>period of deployment shall be extended until 90 days after</u>
- the end of the deployment.
- 17 (4) Possession of a license, together with a copy of the
- 18 person's military orders showing the dates of overseas
- 19 deployment, including the date that the overseas deployment
- 20 <u>ends, shall constitute, during the extension period specified</u>
- in paragraph (3), a defense to any charge filed pursuant to
- 22 section 6106 (relating to firearms not to be carried without

- 23 a license), 6107 (RELATING TO PROHIBITED CONDUCT DURING
- 24 <u>EMERGENCY</u>) or 6108 (relating to carrying firearms on public
- 25 streets or public property in Philadelphia).

- 27 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
