AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, further providing for application for certificate
- 3 of title.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1103.1(d) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1103.1. Application for certificate of title.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (d) Vehicles purchased from dealers.--If the application
- 11 refers to a vehicle purchased from a dealer, the dealer shall
- 12 mail or deliver the application to the department within 20 days
- 13 of the date of purchase. The dealer must accept a separate check
- 14 or money order made payable to the Commonwealth for fees and
- 15 taxes due to the Commonwealth in connection with the
- 16 application. The application shall contain the names and
- 17 addresses of any lienholders in order of priority and the

- 1 amounts and the dates of the security agreements and be assigned
- 2 by the dealer to the owner and signed by the owner. Any dealer
- 3 violating this subsection is guilty of a summary offense and
- 4 shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$50 for
- 5 each violation. The requirement that the dealer mail or deliver
- 6 the application to the department does not apply to vehicles
- 7 purchased by fleet owners or governmental or quasi-governmental
- 8 agencies.

- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
