AN ACT

- 1 Providing for lead-level testing of playgrounds, schools and 2 parks; and making an appropriation.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Lead-Level
- 7 Testing Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Department." The Department of Health of the Commonwealth.
- 13 "Risk area." Any of the following:
- 14 (1) A playground.
- 15 (2) A public, private or parochial elementary or
- 16 secondary school.

- 1 (3) A public park.
- 2 Section 3. Testing and reporting.
- 3 (a) Testing. -- The department shall test the paint in risk
- 4 areas to determine the presence and levels of lead in paint. The
- 5 department shall schedule testing so that all risk areas in this
- 6 Commonwealth are tested within five years.
- 7 (b) Report.--The department shall publish in the
- 8 Pennsylvania Bulletin an annual report of the testing under
- 9 subsection (a).
- 10 Section 4. Appropriation.
- 11 The sum of \$, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is
- 12 hereby appropriated to the Department of Health for the fiscal
- 13 year July 1, 2007, to June 30, 2008, to carry out the provisions
- 14 of this act.
- 15 Section 5. Effective date.
- 16 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
