## AN ACT

15	(b) All privately employed agents, except those who have
16	been granted a waiver from compliance herewith by the
17	commissioner and those who have certification under 42 Pa.C.S.
18	Ch. 29 (relating to officers serving process and enforcing
19	<u>orders),</u> who, as an incidence to their employment, carry a

lethal weapon shall be required to attend the program established by subsection (a) of this section in accordance with the requirements or regulations established by the commissioner and, upon satisfactory completion of such program, shall be entitled to certification by the commissioner. \* \* \*

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
