## AN ACT

- 1 Providing for annual, unannounced inspections of personal care 2 homes; and making a related repeal.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Annual
- 7 Unannounced Inspection of Personal Care Homes Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Department." The Department of Public Welfare of the
- 13 Commonwealth.
- 14 "Personal care home." As defined in section 1001 of the act
- 15 of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public Welfare

- 1 Code.
- 2 Section 3. Annual, unannounced inspection.
- 3 A personal care home shall be subject to requirements set
- 4 forth in section 211 and Articles IX and X of the act of June
- 5 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code, and
- 6 regulations adopted pursuant thereto, except that the annual on-
- 7 site inspection shall be unannounced.
- 8 Section 9. Repeal.
- 9 (a) Intent.--The General Assembly declares that the repeal
- 10 under subsection (b) is necessary to effectuate this act.
- 11 (b) Provision.--Section 211(1) of the act of June 13, 1967
- 12 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code, is repealed.
- 13 Section 10. Effective date.
- 14 This act shall take effect immediately.
