AN ACT

1 Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, further providing for restrictions on the issuance  
3 of one-day tourist fishing licenses and one-day resident  
4 fishing licenses.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Sections 2702(d) and 2702.1(b) of Title 30 of the  
8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:

9 § 2702. Nonresident and tourist licenses.

11 (d) One-day tourist licenses.--Any person required to have a  
12 fishing license under this chapter may fish in any of the waters  
13 of this Commonwealth or in any boundary waters for a period not  
14 to exceed 24 hours, specified by the person at time of purchase,  
15 with a "One-Day Tourist Fishing License" upon payment of license  
16 fee and issuing agent fee as set forth in section 2715. One-Day  
17 Tourist Fishing Licenses shall not be issued for fishing during

1 the period from [April 1] March 15 to April 30 of any year.

2 Holders of One-Day Tourist Fishing Licenses shall not be  
3 required to obtain special permits, including trout/salmon  
4 permits to fish for trout or salmon or special permits to fish  
5 in Lake Erie and tributaries.

6 § 2702.1. One-day resident fishing license.

8 (b) Limitation on issue.--One-Day Resident Fishing Licenses  
9 shall not be issued for fishing during the period from [April 1]  
10 March 15 to April 30 of any year.

12 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
