14	Section 1. Section 18 of the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242,
15	No.86), referred to as the Cosmetology Law, amended June 30,

17	Section 18. Display of LicensesEvery holder of a license
18	granted by the said department, as provided in this act, shall
19	display it in a conspicuous place in his or her principal
20	office, place of business, or employment. <u>A holder of a license,</u>
21	upon request by an inspector, shall present a State-issued photo

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
