## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for issuance and content of driver's license.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 1510(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 1510. Issuance and content of driver's license.
9	(a) General ruleThe department shall, upon payment of the
10	required fee, issue to every qualified applicant a driver's
11	license indicating the type or general class of vehicles the
12	licensee is authorized to drive and any endorsements or
13	restrictions, which license shall contain a distinguishing
14	number assigned by the department to the licensee, the actual
15	name, date of birth, residence address, <u>race,</u> a color photograph
16	or photographic facsimile of the licensee, such other
17	information as may be required by the department, and either a
18	facsimile of the signature of the licensee or a space upon which

the licensee shall write his usual signature with pen and ink. 1 Program participants in the Address Confidentiality Program 2 3 under 23 Pa.C.S. Ch. 67 (relating to domestic and sexual 4 violence victim address confidentiality) may use a substitute address designated by the Office of Victim Advocate as their 5 address. Personal medical data and other information for use in 6 an emergency may be included as a part of the license. 7 8 Information other than that required to identify the licensee, the distinguishing number and the class of license issued may be 9 10 included in microdata form. Except as provided in subsection 11 (f), an applicant shall include his Social Security number on his license application, but the Social Security number shall 12 13 not be included on the license. No driver's license shall be valid until it has been signed by the licensee. 14
